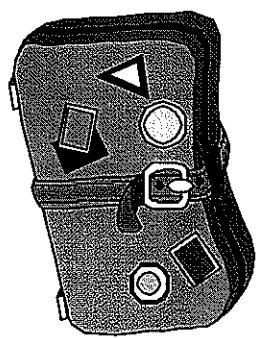

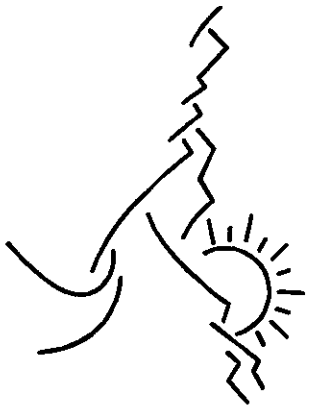


WHAT TO TAKE TO CAMP

North Tapps Middle School's Outdoor Education Program will be conducted at Cispus Environmental Center in Randle, Washington, under the supervision of N.T.M.S. staff, high school counselors, and our school nurse.

The sixth graders will report to school at 8:30 am on Tuesday, then ride district transportation to Cispus. We will stop at Mayfield Dam for a tour and lunch on our way to camp Cispus, upon arrival the sixth graders will be guided by their counselors to settle in their cabins and tour the Centre. After dinner that night, campfire activities will draw to a conclusion a very busy day.

Wednesday and Thursday will be full of workshops dealing with group dynamics, geology of the area, water studies, plant and animal life, hikes, and recreational activities interspersed with meals and social time.

Friday will be focused on bringing to a close the events during the last three days. We will be departing Cispus, stopping for a sack lunch and arriving at N.T.M.S. about 2:15, full of stories and fond memories of our experiences.

The goal of the outdoor education program is to foster an enduring understanding and appreciation of the physical and biological world, while developing skills and attitudes to affect the individual's life long learning and decision making process.
