K-3 Student Unsupervised Bus Drop Off

The Dieringer School District is always concerned with the safety of our students. To help our K-3 students get home safely, it is the Dieringer School District transportation practice to only drop off students in grades kindergarten through third grade when a parent/guardian meets the student at the bus door. Students who are not met at the bus door will be returned to school; their parent contacted to pick them up.

The only exception to this practice is if the parent has filed a ***K-3 Student Permission for Unsupervised Bus Drop Off*** form on file with the school office. Although we do not recommend this practice, the form can be found on the Dieringer School District website (***For Families/Bus Routes/K-3 Student Permission for Unsupervised Bus Drop Off***) and must be returned to the school office.
